

Special Meeting  
Of the  
Assumption Parish Police Jury

Monday, March 28, 2022  
6:00 O'clock p.m.

1. The Special Meeting of the Assumption Parish Police Jury was called to order by Police Jury President Patrick Johnson in the Assumption Parish Police Jury Chamber located at 4813 Highway 1, Napoleonville, Louisiana.
2. Police Jurors recorded as present were: Mr. Ron Alcorn, Ward 1; Mr. Jeff Naquin, Ward 2; Mr. Irving Comeaux, Ward 3; Mr. Patrick Johnson, Ward 4; Mr. Michael Dias, Ward 5; Mr. Chris Carter, Ward 6; Mr. Leroy Blanchard, Ward 7; Mr. Jamie Ponville, Ward 8; Mr. Myron Matherne, Ward 9.
3. President Patrick Johnson led the prayer and Police Juror Chris Carter led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
4. President Patrick Johnson opened the meeting to the public for any public comments, questions or concerns regarding the items listed on the agenda. Following three (3) calls, there were no comments received
5. President Patrick Johnson stated that an official appointment to the State for the Registrar of Voters is needed at this time. Police Juror Ron Alcorn requested that further discussion be held in executive session before the official appointment takes place.
6. Police Juror Ron Alcorn offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Leroy Blanchard, "THAT, the Police Jury approve entering into executive session to discuss the official appointment to the State for the Registrar of Voters position." The motion was unanimously adopted.
7. Police Juror Irving Comeaux offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jeff Naquin, "THAT, the Police Jury approve resuming regular session." The motion was unanimously adopted.
8. President Patrick Johnson informed that the Jury has narrowed the selection for Registrar of Voters to Cheri Williams-Dupaty and Yoselin Jackson.
9. Police Juror Ron Alcorn offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Irving Comeaux, "THAT, the Police Jury approve appointing Yoselin Jackson to the State for the Registrar of Voters position."
10. Police Juror Chris Carter offered a counter motion, seconded by Mr. Leroy Blanchard, "THAT, the Police Jury approve appointing Cheri Williams-Dupaty to the State for the Registrar of Voters position."
11. President Patrick Johnson called for a vote on the countermotion offered by Police Juror Chris Carter:

13. Police Juror Chris Carter stated that all candidates did well and congratulated Yoselin Jackson on her appointment.
14. President Patrick Johnson thanked all the candidates that applied for the position.
15. President Patrick Johnson recognized the Secretary-Treasurer, who stated that advertisement is needed for the Floodplain Manager/Permit Officer position and the OHSEP Director advised that Planning & Zoning be added to the title as well. A discussion was then held regarding the media platform to use and making sure the previous candidates are aware the position has reopened.

16. Police Juror Jeff Naquin offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Leroy Blanchard, "THAT the Police Jury approve the advertising of the Floodplain Manager/Permit Officer/Planning & Zoning position." The motion was unanimously adopted.
17. Police Juror Irving Comeaux offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Jamie Ponville, "THAT, the Police Jury approve and authorize the President to sign a CEA with the State of Louisiana for Capital Outlay Project – Assumption Parish Pumps and Drainage, Planning and Construction CEA 50-J04-21-03." The motion was unanimously adopted.
18. Police Juror Irving Comeaux offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Michael Dias, "THAT, the Police Jury approve to adopt a resolution designating Patrick Johnson to act on behalf of Assumption Parish, in all matters pertaining to the project – Assumption Parish Pumps and Drainage, Planning and Construction CEA 50-J04-21-03, including certifying requests for State disbursements." 19. Vice-President Jeff Naquin recognized Mrs. Yoselin Jackson, who thanked the Police Jury for their appointment and stated that she loves her job and really appreciates the opportunity.
